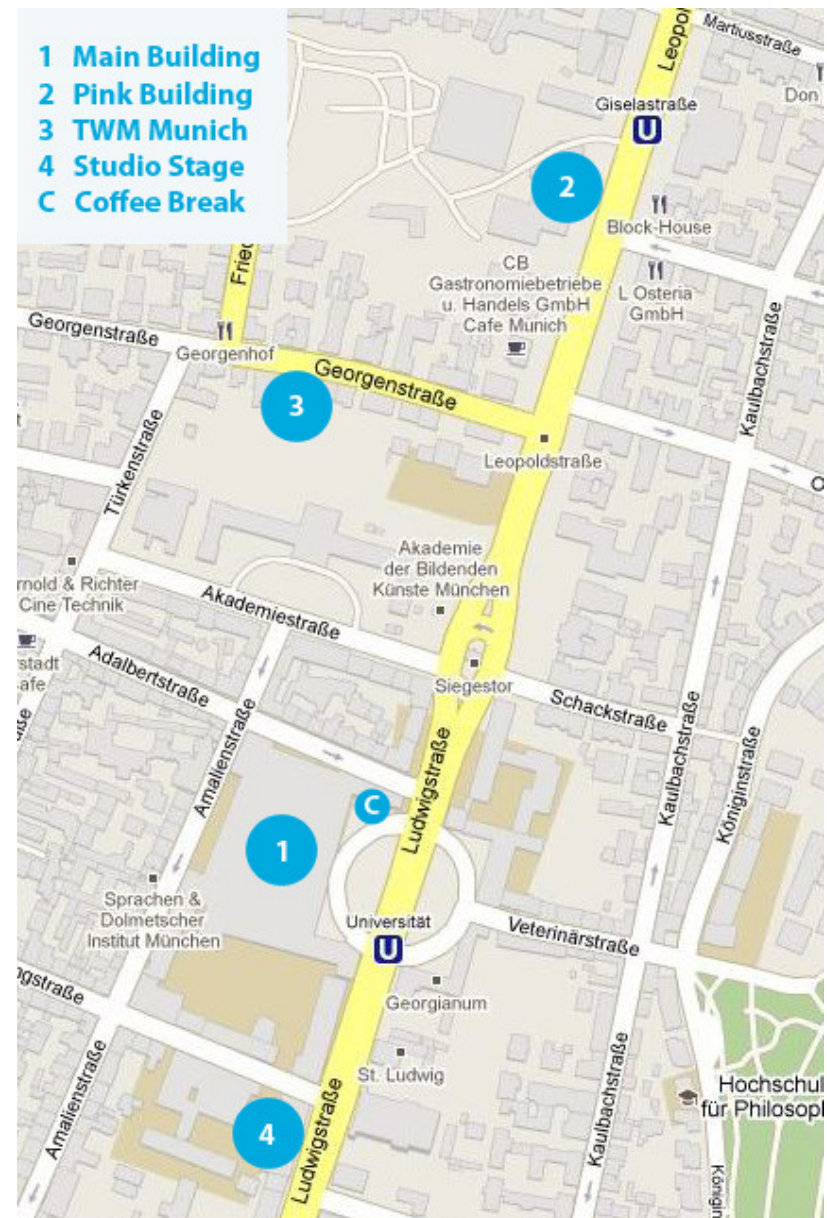

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: “BEING IN MUNICH”

### PUBLIC TRANSPORT (“MVG”)

#### Tickets:

##### Airport-City-Day-Ticket

The Airport-City-Day-Ticket is a day ticket for the entire MVV-network. Valid from the moment of purchase until 6 a.m. the following day. All means of transport within the MVG: S-Bahn, U-Bahn, buses and trams.

→ single: 10.40 €

→ group up to five adults: 18.80 €

Transport from Munich Airport to City Centre: S-Bahn: every 10 min to and from the airport, S1 to “Marienplatz” (48 min) or S8 to “Marienplatz” (38 min)

##### Single Day Ticket

The Single Day Ticket is valid for one adult from the age of 15 onwards. It can be used within the selected district of validity for as many trips as you like on one day.

→ inner district (Innenraum) 5.20 €

##### Partner Day Ticket

The partner day ticket is valid for as many trips as you like for up to five adults.

→ inner district (Innenraum) 9.40 €

##### 3 Days Single Ticket

This Single Ticket is for one adult from the age of 15 onwards. It can be used within the selected district of validity for as many trips as you like on one day. From the moment of validation until 6 am on the fourth day.

→ inner district (Innenraum) 12.80 €

##### Isar Card – Weekly Ticket ([highly recommended](#))

If you wish to make as many trips as you like from Monday till Sunday.

→ inner district (Innenraum) 12.10 €

The City of Munich has the lowest crime rate of any major city in Germany. It is generally safe to use the public transport system and to walk at night.

Banks are usually open on weekdays during the following times: MON – FRI, 8.30 am – 14.00 pm. ATMs (Automatic Teller Machines/cash points) can be found everywhere in Munich, including around the congress venues.

The currency in Germany is Euro. At most banks as well as at exchange bureaus in the city currency can be exchanged. Credit cards are widely accepted.
